Got a loose ring?

Trawler haynet tie-up rings are fitted at time of manufacture. However, during initial transit, they can sometimes work loose.

Once the haynet is in use the ring will become firmly attached and should not need re-affixing. If your ring has come adrift in the packaging, here's how to fix it!



1. Gather all the haynet loops together and ready the ring along side.



2. Feed the haynet loops through the ring.



3. Fold the loops over the ring at either side.



4. Push down the haynet loops left and right of the ring.



5. Pull the ring through until the haynet loops lock.



6. Ensure all the loops are grouped together and pull tight.



7. The loops will lock even more strongly, the harder the ring is pulled in use.

This method of ring attachment is used extensively in the fishing industry and is designed for quick attachment whilst ensuring a non-abrasive action when in motion. This equally applies to haynet use.
